San Jose Water Company (U-168-W) (SJWC) hereby transmits for filing the following changes in tariff schedules applicable to its service area and which are attached hereto:

Background

Senate Bill 7 (SB 7), signed into law on September 25, 2016, adds a provision to the California water code that prohibits water utilities like SJWC from providing water service to new multiunit residential structures or new mixed-use (residential/commercial) structures unless the residences in those buildings are metered or submetered.

SJWC's current Tariff Rule 19 addresses "Service to Separate Premises and Multiple Units, and Resale of Water." To implement the new requirement of SB 7, SJWC proposes to add a section at the end of Tariff Rule 19 that includes the relevant specific language of SB 7. This will facilitate SJWC's ability to enforce this mandate with developers of new construction.

Specifically, SJWC proposes to add the following new section at the end of Rule 19:

D. Newly Constructed Multiunit Structures

In compliance with Water Code Section 537.1, the utility shall not sell, lease, rent, furnish, or deliver water service to a newly constructed multiunit residential structure or newly constructed mixed-use residential and commercial structure for which an application for a water connection, or more than one connection, is submitted, without requiring a measurement of the quantity of water supplied to each individual residential dwelling unit as a condition of new water service. The measurement may be by individual water meters or submeters.

<u>Purpose</u>

In accordance with General Order (GO) No. 96B – Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3), this advice letter is designated as a Tier 1 Advice Letter. With this advice letter, SJWC requests authority to update the Rule 19 to comply with the requirements of SB 7.

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to GO No. 96-B and in accordance with Commission direction. This advice letter will have no impact on rates.

Effective Date

SJWC requests that the updated tariff sheets become effective upon 5 days after the filing of this advice letter.

<u>Protests and Responses</u>

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response does not oppose the filing but presents information that may prove useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
