These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Orders Nos. 96-B – Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3) and pursuant to the authority established by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) in Resolution (Res.) W-5071, dated December 3, 2015 (Attachment A) and Res.

W-5095, dated April 21, 2016 (**Attachment B**). This advice letter is designated a Tier II Advice Letter in compliance with GO 96B.

#### Effective Date

SJWC requests that the proposed surcharges become reinstated effective June 1, 2017.

#### Purpose

With this advice letter SJWC seeks to re-instate two surcharges: 1) A \$0.08 per 100 cubic feet surcharge to amortize the uncollected balance of \$996,023 remaining from the recovery of the previously authorized 2014 Mandatory Conservation Revenue Adjustment Memorandum Account originally approved in Res. W-5071, and 2) A \$0.1441 per 100 cubic feet surcharge to amortize the uncollected balance of \$2,232,698 remaining from the recovery of the 2015 Water Conservation Memorandum Account originally approved in Res. W-5095.

#### Background

On December 3, 2015, the Commission authorized Res. W-5071 granting SJWC's request to recover in rates \$4,258,794 by adding a surcharge of \$0.08 per 100 cubic feet to the Quantity Rates in each customer's bill to be recovered over twelve months. The surcharge is intended to recover lost revenues tracked in SJWC's Mandatory Conservation Revenue Adjustment Memorandum Account (MCRAMA), using Commission approved Water Conservation Memorandum Account (WCMA) methodology, resulting from reduced water consumption by customers during the period of April 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.

Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of Res. W-5071 (included in Attachment A), states that:

- "3. San Jose Water Company is authorized to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter to make effective the following tariff schedules as attached to this Resolution five days after approval of this Resolution:
  - a. Schedule No. 1, General Metered Service;
  - b. Schedule No. 1B, General Metered Service with Automatic Fire Sprinkler System;
  - c. Schedule No. 1C, General Metered Service for Mountain District;
  - d. Schedule No. RW, Raw Water Metered Service.
  - 4. San Jose Water Company is authorized to cancel the corresponding tariffs for the presently effective rate schedules listed in the Ordering Paragraph 3 above."

On December 4, 2015, SJWC then submitted Advice Letter 477 to implement the surcharge for recovery of the under-collection of the 2014 MCRAMA with an effective date of December 9, 2015. This advice letter was subsequently approved on December 28, 2015 with an effective date of December 9, 2015.

On December 9, 2016, twelve months from initial effective date of the 2014 MCRAMA surcharge implementation, the \$0.08 per 100 cubic feet surcharge was terminated as required by the ordering paragraph above. Upon the surcharge termination there was a remaining undercollected balance of \$996,023 (Attachment C). This under-collection is due primarily to the fact that actual sales are substantially lower than the Commission authorized sales estimate used to calculate the surcharge amount.

On April 21, 2016, the Commission authorized Res. W-5095 granting SJWC authority to implement a surcharge of \$0.1441 per 100 cubic feet added to the quantity rates over twelve months to recover the \$7,667,713 balance in the 2015 WCMA. The surcharge is intended to recover lost revenues tracked in SJWC's MCRAMA, using Commission approved WCMA methodology, resulting from reduced water consumption by customers during the period of January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.

Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of Res. W-5095 (included in Attachment B), states that:

- "3. San Jose Water Company is authorized to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter to make effective the following tariff schedules as attached to this Resolution five days after approval of this Resolution:
  - a. Schedule No. 1, General Metered Service;
  - b. Schedule No. 1B, General Metered Service with Automatic Fire Sprinkler System;
  - c. Schedule No. 1C, General Metered Service for Mountain District;
  - d. Schedule No. RW, Raw Water Metered Service.
- 4. San Jose Water Company is authorized to cancel the corresponding tariffs for the presently effective rate schedules listed in the Ordering Paragraph 3 above."

On April 22, 2016, SJWC submitted Advice Letter 486 to implement the surcharge for recovery of the under-collection of the 2015 WCMA with an effective date of April 26, 2016. This advice letter was subsequently approved with an effective date of April 26, 2016. The surcharge began appearing on customer's bills May 12, 2016.

Twelve months from initial effective date of the 2015 WCMA surcharge implementation, the \$0.1441 per 100 cubic feet surcharge was terminated as required by the ordering paragraph above. Upon the surcharge termination there was a remaining under-collected balance of \$2,232,698 (Attachment D). This under-collection is also due primarily to actual sales being substantially lower than the Commission authorized sales estimate used to calculate the surcharge amount.

Therefore, with this Advice Letter, SJWC seeks to reinstate both of the surcharges; \$0.08 per 100 cubic feet surcharge to recover the remaining \$996,023 balance from the 2014 MCRAMA and \$0.1441 per 100 cubic feet surcharge to recover the remaining \$2,232,698 balance from the 2015 WCMA. Further delay in the amortization would create intergenerational inequity brought about by future customers paying for revenue shortfall incurred in 2014 and 2015. Clearly, some intergenerational inequity already exists, however, by allowing re-implementation of the Balancing Account associated surcharge the Commission will help mitigate this effect. SJWC recommends maintaining the surcharge at \$0.0492 per 100 cubic feet to avoid customer confusion that would be caused by fluctuating surcharge levels. SJWC estimates that, with an effective date of June 1, 2017, the under-collected balances of the accounts would be recovered in less than 12 months. SJWC's billing system will allow the company to monitor the account balance and terminate the surcharges when the balance has been collected.

Public notices were originally provided with Advice Letters 468 and 482.

#### Rate Calculation and Average Bill Comparison

Current rates became effective March 20, 2017 by AL 506.

As discussed above, SJWC proposes to reinstate the \$0.08 per 100 cubic feet surcharge authorized by Res. 5071 and the \$0.1441 per 100 cubic feet surcharge authorized by Res. 5095. As a result of this surcharge the bill for a residential customer using 15 ccf per month will increase by \$3.36, or 3.30% (Attachment E).

#### Protests and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response does not oppose the filing but presents information that may prove useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;

- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. When submitting a response or protest please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

- 3. The utility will supply at the point of connection only such raw water at such pressures as may be available from time to time from the Santa Clara Valley Water District. The customer shall indemnify the utility and save it harmless from any and all claims arising out of service under this schedule and shall further agree to make no claims against the utility for any loss, damage or injury resulting from service under this schedule.
