The San Jose Water Company (U-168-W) (SJWC) hereby transmits for filing the following changes in tariff schedules applicable to its service area and which are attached hereto:

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order (GO) No. 96-B, Water Industry Rule 4.3, 7.3.2.(4). This advice letter is designated a Tier II Advice Letter in compliance with GO 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.2.(4). SJWC requests that the relief requested become effective October 20, 2018 (30 days from filing).

By this filing SJWC requests that the Upsized Charges and Special Conditions 1 and 2 listed in Schedule No. 1B, General Metered Service with Automatic Fire Sprinkler System's Upsize Service Charges, also apply to Schedule 1C, General Service Mountain District, while maintaining the interruptible service special condition of Schedule 1C.

SJWC has received requests to install General Metered Service with Automatic Fire Sprinkler System in the Mountain District. Currently, the Mountain District served under Schedule 1C does not have provisions for the Upsize Charges and other Special Conditions contained within Schedule 1B, General Metered Service with Automatic Fire Sprinkler System. Customers currently served under Schedule 1C are assessed a quantity rate for usage over 20 ccf per month and have an interruptible service provision contained in Schedule 1C's Special Conditions. These same conditions are not contained within Schedule 1B. It is anticipated that Automatic

Fire Sprinkler Systems will continue to be requested in the Mountain District due to the State of California's requirement for fire sprinklers in new home construction.

The California Building Standards Commission approved the State Fire Marshal's Building, Fire and Residential Code adoption packages for the 2010 California Building Standards Codes at the hearing on January 12, 2010. The 2010 California Building Standards Codes was published July 1, 2010, with an effective date of January 1, 2011. A key component in the 2010 code adoption is the addition of residential fire sprinklers in all new one-and two-family dwellings and townhouse construction statewide. For many years, installation of fire sprinkler systems has only been required in office buildings and multi-family dwellings (i.e. apartments). These sprinkler systems are proven to save lives and extinguish fires. Prior to the adoption of the 2010 California Building Standards Codes, more than 150 jurisdictions in California had a local residential fire sprinkler ordinance.

Protests and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response does not oppose the filing but presents information that may prove useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:


