These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Orders Nos. 96-B – Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3) and pursuant to the authority established by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) in Decision (D.) 14-08-006, dated August 14, 2014 (**Attachment A**). This advice letter is designated a Tier I Advice Letter in compliance with GO 96B.

Effective Date

SJWC requests that the proposed surcharges become effective January 15, 2016.

Purpose

With this advice letter SJWC seeks to re-implement a \$0.0492 per 100 cu. ft surcharge to amortize the uncollected balance of \$589,751 remaining from the recovery originally approved in D.14-08-006.

Background

SJWC filed Application 12-01-003 on January 3, 2012. In the Application SJWC sought, among other items, CPUC authorization to increase rates for the Test Year 2013 and Escalation Years 2014 and 2015. On August 14th, 2014, the Commission issued D.14-08-006 authorizing rate increases for the years outlined above as well as the recovery of the under-collection of various balancing accounts and the refund of various memorandum accounts.

Ordering Paragraph No.8 of D.14-08-006 (included in Attachment A), states that:

"8. San Jose Water Company is authorized to recover the \$2,598,912 undercollection in various balancing accounts via a 12-month surcharge of \$0.0492 per hundred cubic feet, and provide a refund of \$650,456 undercollection through a surcredit of \$0.25 per service connection per month for 12 months for various memorandum accounts."

On August 18, 2014, SJWC submitted Advice Letter 463 to implement the surcharge for recovery of the under-collection of the balancing accounts and a surcredit to refund the over-collection of the various memorandum accounts with an effective date of August 15, 2014. This advice letter was subsequently approved effective August 15, 2014.

On August 14th, 2015, twelve months from initial effective date of the balancing account surcharge implementation, the \$0.0492 per 100 ccf surcharge was terminated as required by the

ordering paragraph above. Upon the surcharge termination there was a remaining under-collected balance of \$589,751 (**Attachment B**). This under-collection is due primarily to actual sales being substantially lower than the Commission authorized sales estimate which was used to calculate the surcharge amount.

With this Advice Letter SJWC seeks to re-implement the \$0.0492 per 100 ccf surcharge to recover the remaining \$589,751 balance from the balancing accounts. If the remaining undercollection of the Balancing Account balance is not amortized until SJWC's next General Rate Case (for Test Year 2019) this will create intergenerational inequity brought about by customers in 2019 paying for revenue shortfall incurred in 2010/2012. Clearly, some intergenerational inequity already exists, however, by allowing re-implementation of the Balancing Account associated surcharge the Commission will help mitigate this effect. SJWC recommends maintaining the surcharge at \$0.0492 per ccf to avoid customer confusion that would be caused by fluctuating surcharge levels. SJWC estimates that, with an effective date of January 15, 2016, the under-collected balance of the account would be recovered within approximately 6 months. SJWC's billing system will allow the company to monitor the account balance and terminate the surcharge when the balance has been collected.

Additionally, with this AL, SJWC will remove the memorandum account surcredit verbiage from the tariff sheets. On September 16th, 2015, thirteen months from initial effective date of the memorandum account surcredit implementation, the \$0.25 per service connection surcredit was terminated. While this was required by the ordering paragraph to be in effect for 12 months, given that this was a refund to customers the surcredit was continued until the over-collection was eliminated. Upon the surcredit termination there was a balance of \$4,018 which had been over-refunded to customers.

Public notice is not required as notice was completed at the time of SJWC's filing of A.12-01-003.

Rate Calculation and Average Bill Comparison

Rates became effective September 20, 2015 by AL 476.

As discussed above, SJWC proposes to re-implement the \$0.0492 per 100 ccf surcharge authorized by the Commission Decision 14-08-006. As a result of this surcharge the bill for a customer using 15 ccf per month will increase by \$0.74, or 0.86% (Attachment C).

Protests and Responses

- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. 
